Dear Friends,

As 2022 winds down, we want to thank all of you for your support in getting VVAW's first library open for the middle school in Pho Vinh, Quang Ngai Province. We know it is much appreciated by the students and the residents and has been receiving lots of use in 2022.

Things are falling into place for construction of our next library, scheduled to begin in early December, in the courtyard of the Hanh Trung Primary School, Nghia Hanh District, in the Quang Ngai Province of Vietnam. This will be a "Small Dream" library—meaning it will be smaller than our previous library and only one story tall. Your donations will help us raise the \$26,000 needed to get this open by spring of 2023, weather and unforeseen issues permitting.

The Library of Vietnam Project is now partnering with Project RENEW whose mission is to make Quang Tri Province safe from the impact of cluster munitions and explosive ordnance, creating an environment in which communities can live with confidence that they are safe, and vulnerable groups will receive the support they need. They have officially expanded their focus to include Quang Ngai Province, where VVAW's libraries are located. They will be putting children's books on War Legacy Education in the libraries across Quang Ngai.

VVAW intends to continue supporting these library projects with construction or enhancements to equipment, or whatever the libraries need to better help the students. We've been talking with Chuck Theusch from the Library of Vietnam Project about how we can continue to support these two libraries and maybe even build more over the next 5 years.

This may not seem like a lot, but in these remote war-torn, poverty-stricken areas every dollar goes a long way to making big improvements for the people of Vietnam. This is a great chance to bring some joy into our lives by helping the children and grandchildren of people we once wronged.
